This is a request to accept bids on property, Lots 1, 2 & 3 of the Herman Subdivision. We would like to advertise the three properties with the contingency that any interested applicant would be required to submit a Development Plan with a construction time line, that would be binding with the sale, such that property could not be acquired as an investment and sit on it for many years, as we would like to see some development, so we will evaluate based on development potential. 3) NDDOT Main Street Initiative Focus Area

Planning Department has suggested we expand our original version, to include Main Street, between 6th & 11th, 2nd Ave W., between 4th Street and 11th Street and then 11th Street in front of Harmon Park. Two days after this was put on the Agenda, the State informed us they are going to have another meeting and may change the grant proposal and we won't know for sure until after the December 11, 2017 meeting. Requesting approval of focus area as amended for submittal to the State.
