Advertisement for Bids

JE Dunn, as Construction Manager at Risk, is taking bids on Bid Package 3 on December 14, 2017 until 2:00 pm CST. No bids will be accepted after 2:00 pm. This will be for the remainder of the Terminal Project.

The scopes of work for which we are accepting bids are:

INDEPENDENT TESTING LAB & SERVICES, FINAL CLEANING, SURVEYING, ELEVATED CONCRETE DECKS, PRECAST SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION, MASONRY & EXTERIOR STONE, STRUCTURAL STEEL SUPPLY (PARTIAL), STRUCTURAL STEEL ERECTION (PARTIAL), MISC. METALS, STAIRS, RAILINGS, GLASS RAILINGS, DAMPPROOFING AND WATERPROOFING, MISC. Bids must be submitted by one of the following methods:

1. Mailed to the JE Dunn Williston office 501 E Broadway, Williston, ND 58801. Bids that are mailed must be received one day in advance (by December 13th).
2. Hand delivered to The Williston Recreation Center 822 18th ST E, Williston ND 58801 Meeting room #3.

All bidders must be licensed for the full amount of the bid per sections. If not, the bid will be rejected and the contract awarded to the next lowest responsible bidder.

The Bid Proposal Form and Scope of Work should be filled out correctly, signed and dated. DBE info also needs to be submitted with bid.

After all bids are opened and read aloud, at a later date JE Dunn then shall evaluate the bids and determine which is the most responsible.

The Governing body reserves the right to reject any and all bids and rebid the project until a satisfactory bid is received based on past experiences with a subcontractor or a current legal dispute with a subcontractor.
