It is really happening! April 2017 was a big month for the XWA project. Literally on Friday April 21st, the earth started moving at the site of the new airport. Construction is finally underway.



Announcements

- ✓ Anthony Dudas was officially named Airport Director. Mr. Dudas is responsible for overseeing the current airport and is involved with discussions pertaining to the new airport.
- ✓ Ulteig was announced as the Construction Administration and Construction Observation manager for the XWA 2017 Projects. Ulteig is responsible for overseeing:
 - (1) Site Grading;
 - (2) Reroute of 59th Street;
 - (3) Terminal Surcharge, Access Roads, and Staging Area.
- ✓ Ulteig/AE2S were announced as partners in the XWA Program Coordinator role. Together, Ulteig/AE2S, will oversee the construction of the new airport, acting as the coordinator to manage activities of KLJ (Engineer of Record), Tribal Coordination Entities, the FAA, and other regulatory agencies/partners, stakeholders, landowners, and the City.

On the Ground

- ✓ The site grading (Martin Construction), and surcharge project (Rachel Contracting), are going very well. It is anticipated that the surcharge project will be completed by late May, possibly early June.

- ✓ Initial work for the 59th street re-route is scheduled to begin in May.
- ✓ The City of Williston began working collectively with JE Dunn to establish a GMP, (Guaranteed Maximum Price), for the new terminal at XWA Williston International Basin Airport.
- ✓ JE Dunn, KLJ, and Alliance continue to collaborate regarding the necessary design needs for the Williston ARFF/SRE (Air Rescue Fire Fighting and Snow Removal Equipment) project.
