

## **ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Williston, North Dakota, will receive sealed Bids at Williston City Hall until September 19, 2018 at the hour of 3:00 p.m. local time for the purpose of furnishing all materials, labor, equipment and skill required for the construction of the **Williston XWA Airport Pump Station / Reservoir**, and incidental items, for said City, as is more fully described and set forth in the Plans and Specifications which are on file in the office of the City Engineering Department. Bids will be opened at the Williston City Hall at 3:00 p.m. local time, 22 East Broadway, Williston, ND, and read aloud.

Bids shall be mailed or delivered to City Auditor, City of Williston, 22 East Broadway, Williston, ND 58801 or P.O. Box 1306, Williston, ND 58802.

The Work is comprised of two (2) Contracts: Contract No. 1 – General Construction; and Contract No. 2 – Electrical Construction. Individual Bids will be received for each Contract as well as Contract No. 3 – Combined General and Electrical Construction. The Owner will not accept a combined Bid unless that Bid is lower than the combined total of the lowest and best Bids for the Separate Contracts. The Work for each Contract is generally described as follows:

### **Contract No. 1 – General Construction:**

Work generally includes: Excavation and construction of a 500,000 gallon underground fire water storage reservoir, a 10,000 gallon underground domestic use water reservoir and a pump station, approximately 1,000 square feet constructed of precast concrete wall panels and open web steel joist and steel corrugated roof to house two 4,000 gallon per minute vertical turbine pumps, three 350 gallon per minute centrifugal pumps, a double back flow preventer, two electrically operated butterfly valves and miscellaneous piping, fittings and appurtenances.

### **Contract No.2 – Electrical Construction:**

Electrical construction shall consist of the following major components associated with the construction of the new pump station:

- New Electrical Main Service Switchgear.
- Distribution of <600V Power for process equipment including MCCs and variable frequency drives.
- Mechanical, Lighting, Communications and General Power items.
- Process equipment power and an automated supervisory control and data acquisition (SCADA) control system.
- Engine Generator.

### **Contract No.3 – Combined General and Electrical Construction:**

Work generally includes construction consisting of all Work described under Contracts No. 1 and No. 2.

All Work shall be done in accordance with the Bidding Documents on file in the Office of the City Engineering Department. Copies of the Bidding Documents may be seen and examined at the offices of the Engineer, AE2S, the office of the Williston City Engineering Department, and at Builders Exchanges in Williston, Bismarck, Minot, Grand Forks, Fargo, and Minneapolis. All bidding document interpretations and clarifications should be directed to the office of AE2S at (218) 299-5610.

Bids shall be submitted on the Bid Forms provided and in accordance with the Bidding Documents. No bids will be considered unless sealed and filed at the City of Williston. Each bid shall be accompanied by a separate envelope containing bid security and other requirements of the bid, in an opaque envelope, which shall be plainly marked with the project title and the name and address of the Bidder. Bid security in the amount of 5% of the amount of the bid must accompany each bid in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders. Bid security of the three lowest Bidders will be retained until the contract has been awarded and executed, but not longer than sixty (60) days from the date of the bid opening.

All Bidders shall have a valid North Dakota Contractor's license of the appropriate Class for the work, as required by Section 43-07-05 (NDCC). Bidders shall enclose a copy of their license or Certificate of Renewal in the same envelope as the Bidders Bond, as required under 43-07-12 (NDCC). No Bid will be read or considered unless it fully complies with the Bond and license requirements. Any deficient Bid will be resealed and returned to the Bidder.

The City of Williston reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any irregularities or informalities therein and to award the Contract in the best interests of the Owner. No Bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the bid opening.
