## Moving Days!

Time to move! Next week you will be provided boxes and labels for you to pack up your spaces. On Monday morning October 7<sup>th</sup> movers will be on site to commence moving your packed boxes and furnishings to the new airport. We encourage you to pack and move as much as possible in the pre-move ahead of the overnight move on October 9<sup>th</sup>. In addition to packing up items to move, there are two dumpsters located at the airport maintenance building. The one near the gate is for scrape metal only and the dumpster near the maintenance office is for general trash. After the last flight departs ISN the overnight move will be underway. Movers will be placing your boxes and equipment in your designated spaces and it will be your responsibility to unpack boxes and organize your spaces. Please contact a Chrysalis representative (Scott Vriesman or Moe Crawford) for any questions on the moving process.



**Chrysalis will be distributing boxes and labels to tenants on September 30<sup>th</sup>.**



In addition to the dumpsters, there are shredder bins located in airport administration for any documents that require shredding. There will be an e-waste container on site the week of October 7<sup>th</sup> for any computers or peripherals such as monitors, printers, and keyboards. Reminder, any sensitive or personally identifiable information will not be handled by the movers and is the tenant's responsibility.

Opening day is in sight! The activity level is high at your new Williston Basin International Airport. There is an excitement in the air as the construction team of hundreds is wrapping up all the project areas that make up your new airport. However, October 10<sup>th</sup> does not mean the end of all construction activity, as there will still be areas of work continuing. 

## Tenant Familiarization

Managers and Supervisors, please ensure your employees are afforded the opportunity to conduct familiarization walks of your new airport. This walk will allow employees to learn their path into the building, work location, and parking area. There will be an explanation of card reader door access and restricted areas to better equip you for the first day of operations at XWA.

## Terminal Traffic Lanes

There are four traffic lanes directly in front of the terminal on Jensen Lane. The outermost lane shaded orange will be for Hotel and Oilfield Shuttles only. The center two lanes are thru lanes and no parking, stopping, loading, unloading, or standing is permitted in these two lanes. The closest lane in front of the terminal shaded green is for passenger loading and unloading only. No parking or standing is permitted in this lane. Lastly, the Taxi Stand shaded blue will be queueing in the lane north of the terminal at the flag poles and extend around the curve of the loop road. Plans are also shown for future ride app pick up area shaded yellow.

## Airport Badging

The badging process is well underway for all tenants and employees of the new airport. Even contractors working at the airport after opening day will require badging, if their work requires access to the AOA, secure, or sterile areas. If you haven't done so already contact Ryan O'Rear, Assistant Director, in Airport Admin for the required badge form in order to get your ID verification and fingerprinting scheduled. Once that initial step is complete you will be receiving an email which will schedule your training date and time. Those training times begin Monday, Sept 30<sup>th</sup>.
