Overland Aviation FBO

Through the City of Williston’s Request for Proposal process in July 2018, Overland Aviation was selected to be the Fixed Base Operator (FBO) at the new Williston Basin International Airport. Since then, an abundance of researching, planning, & designing has taken place. This spring will welcome an additional flurry of construction activity to the north of the commercial terminal, where the 51,000 sq ft Overland Aviation facility will be situated.

Overland Aviation’s facility at the Williston Basin International Airport will include an executive passenger terminal and pilot lounge, a private terminal for oil-laborer crew change flights, as well as management and rental office spaces. Overland Aviation’s heated hangar will be capable of storing large aircraft up to a Gulfstream G650. Also located within the Overland Aviation facility will be a U.S. Customs and Border Protection General Aviation Facility, essentially opening the door for aircraft from all corners of the world to clear U.S. Customs at the Williston Basin International Airport. *(Continued on Page 3)*

Progress continues with 223 days remaining before opening day. Mechanical ducting, electrical conduit, and plumbing piping are filling the mechanical spaces within the terminal, as walls continue to take shape. The most notable design features starting to show in the exterior framing are the slender window openings. Note the window openings on the design rendering above and now evident in the image below. All project teams are anticipating the spring thaw to continue the many remaining projects. A list of those projects is found below.





Rumor has it... There will be a restaurant & bar located in the XWA terminal.


True!
