200 Days!

In 200 days, on October 10, 2019, operations will commence at the Williston Basin International Airport (XWA). The terminal is now 55% complete and as the spring thaw takes place the Terminal's exterior finishes are being installed. The pace of work and number of people on site each day has greatly increased to over 100 workers in and around the terminal. The various paving projects will be commencing soon, which will more than triple the onsite workforce. In addition to the increased workforce, excavation equipment and truck traffic will also increase, which will require added vigilance as personnel move around the project. Safety and awareness are critical as projects ramp up this spring. Projects in bold and underlined at left are work in progress. The list will be updated in future newsletters as other projects start back up in the coming months.




Rumor has it... County Road 7 will be paved.
