ISN Environmental Study

Airport Operations would like to inform all ISN tenants about an upcoming environmental study. Personnel from Carlson McCain will be conducting the study, which requires access to all areas of Sloulin Field, including access within tenant facilities. Airport Operations staff will be providing escort as required and your assistance where necessary is appreciated. This study is a critical phase in the decommissioning of Sloulin Field after the airport moves to XWA on October 10th.



Important Relocation Notice for General Aviation Aircraft

Do you have aircraft parked or hangared on Sloulin Field? As we approach the end of operations at Sloulin Field International Airport preparations for the move to XWA are well underway. A critical part of the move is ensuring General Aviation (GA) tenants are well informed and are preparing for the end of operations at ISN. Plans should be in the works to ensure all GA aircraft are flown out of Sloulin Field on or by October 10, 2019. Special Flight Permits (Ferry Permits) and special permission from the City of Williston will be required for the departure of any aircraft remaining at ISN after October 10th. Overland Aviation’s FBO facility at XWA will be open and operating on October 10, 2019 for GA aircraft.
